



HALLOWEEN CIRCA 1904

Resized to 8 ½" finished blocks

Cutting instructions **per block**:

4 - 3" squares

2 – 5" squares cut once on diagonal (forms half square triangles placed around 4 center squares)

12 – 2" squares of background fabric cut once on diagonal (forms half square triangles around each block)

12 – 2" squares of star point fabric cut once on diagonal (forms half square triangles with the above to form 24 half square triangles for **each block**)

4 – 1 ¼" corner squares

Do a seam check prior to starting. Once you sew 2 each 3" square together and wind up with a 3" X 5 ½" rectangle, you can start sewing and everything should match with minimal pinning if any.

You can use any method you wish to make your half square triangles. The instruction I included here are for cutting 2" squares, cutting in half on diagonal once, sewing background and star point fabrics together, then sizing them down to 1 ¼" unfinished. (This size sounds much scarier than it is.)

Pay close attention to the direction of the star points on each block because they do turn.
