**Cherries Blocks Centers - Bee Blocks**

Three cherry blocks: 2 cherries blocks and one block goes inside 8 x 8 Churn dash (Churn Dash block to be done next week)

Plain cherries blocks

Stems	cherries <b>D-1</b>	leaves <b>D-15</b>	backgrounds
5/8" by 10" med brown	two--2x2 dark pink	three 2x2" lt. green	5 x 5
two 5/8" by 10" lt. brown	two--2x2 pink	three 2x2" med. green	5 x 5
	two--2 x 2 spicy red		5 x 5

Use interfacing method on all leaves and cherries, or your favorite method for appliqué. I prefer using Karen Kay Buckley's perfect circles for any small circle, and I use needle-turn appliqué. Stitch a giant running stitch on three leaves for contrast, before appliqueing them down. (one per block).



After appliqueing, trim to 4 1/2" square.

Measurements for Churn Dash parts:

Outer HSTs: two 3' x 3', two each of background and feature fabric, make HSTs. Yield for each block: four 2 1/2" square triangles.

Rectangles on four sides: 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" see picture for visuals: four print, four background for each Churn Dash square (four different prints and four different backgrounds)



Hexie Flowers--four of them in quilt.

Background	7" x 7" squares	Embroidery, do before Applique
Hexie Shape D-33	6" x 6"	Around edges, outlining hexie shape
Center Shape D-10	2-1/2" x 2-1/2"	Around edges, outlining hexie shape

I decided to just do a regular flower hexie, using 1" hexie shapes:
