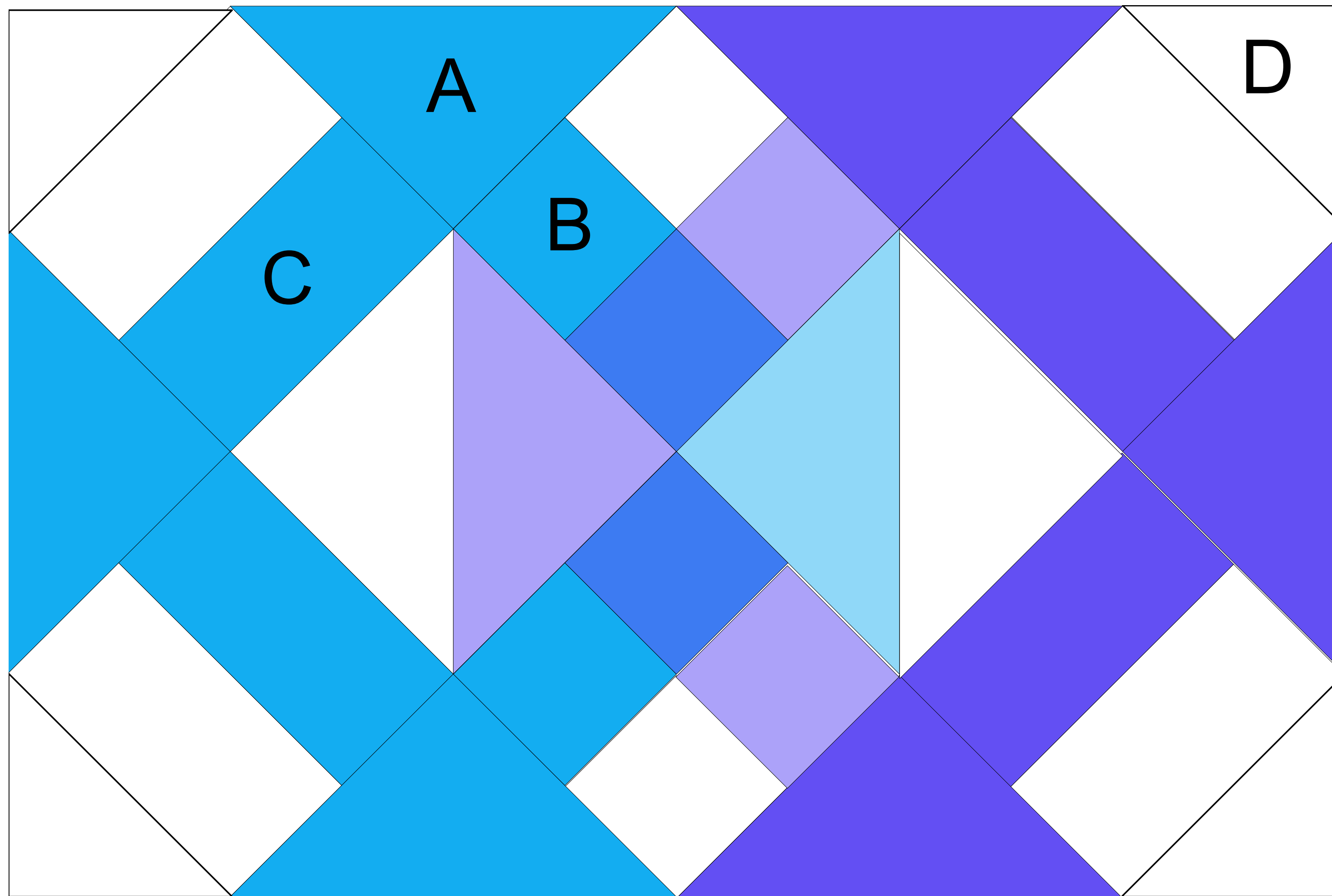

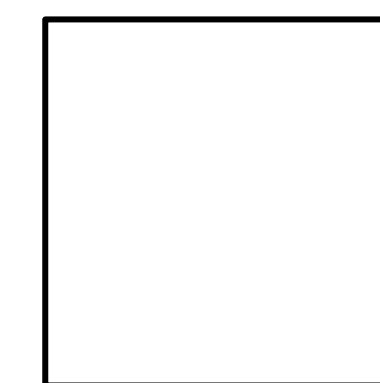
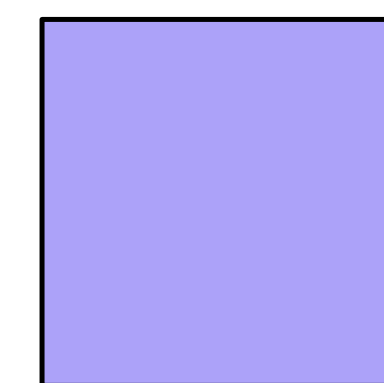
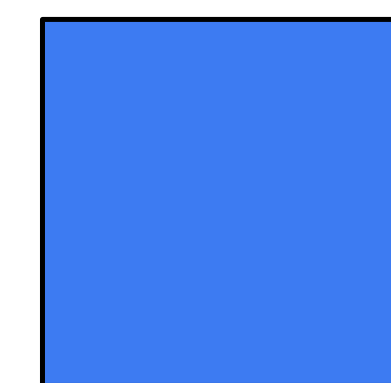
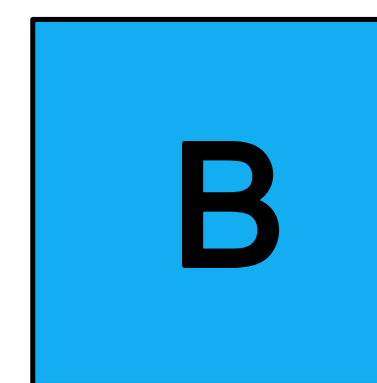
Rough-cut sketch of the shapes and blocks I used to tilt two snugged Churn Dash Blocks tipped on their sides.

The operative word is "rough-cut" so there may be some trimming when you square it up.

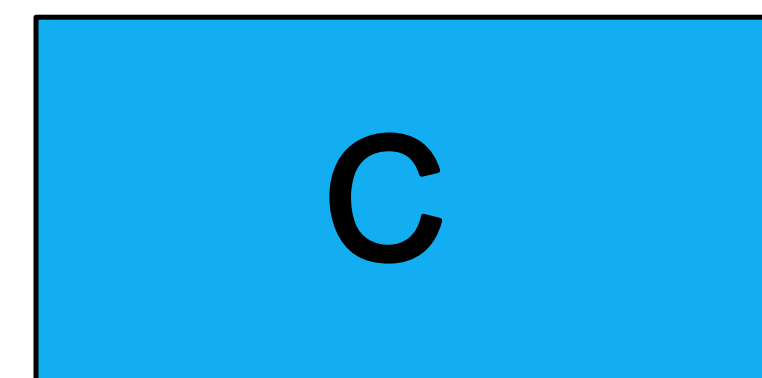
Use combinations of colors to create transparency.

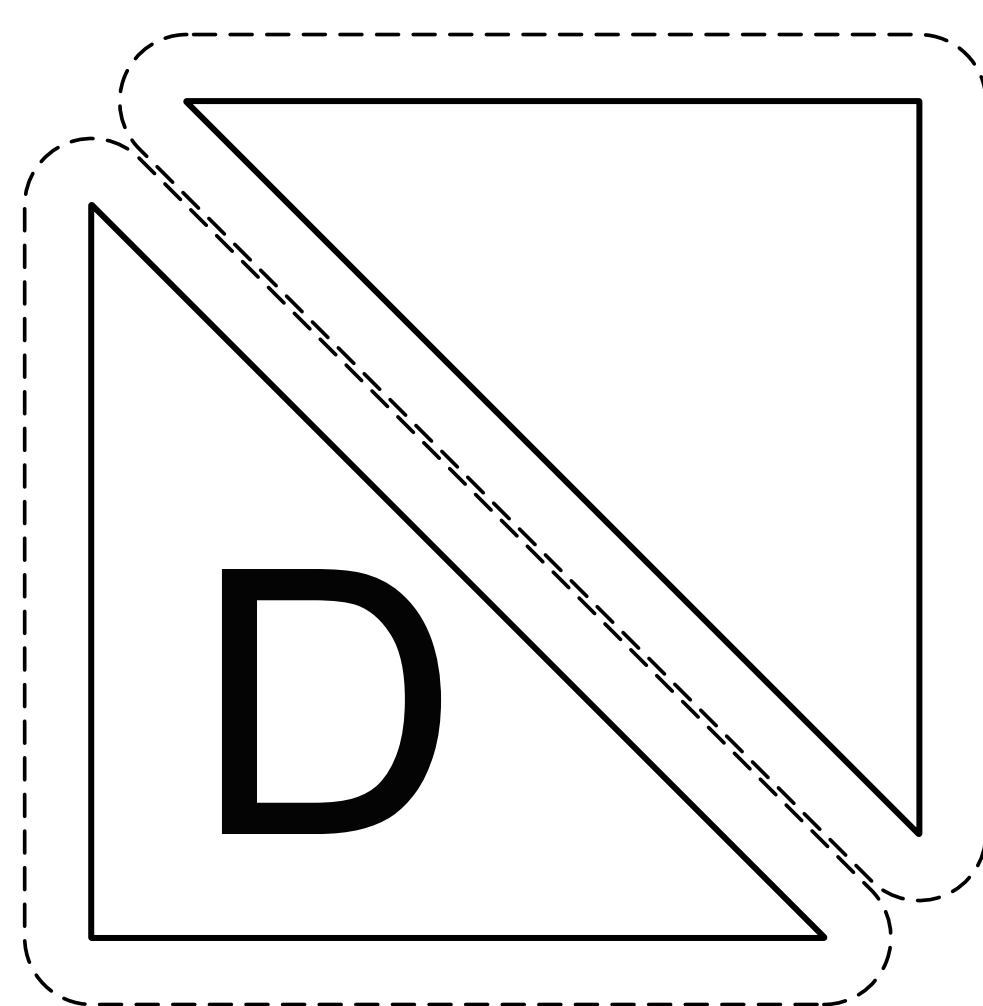
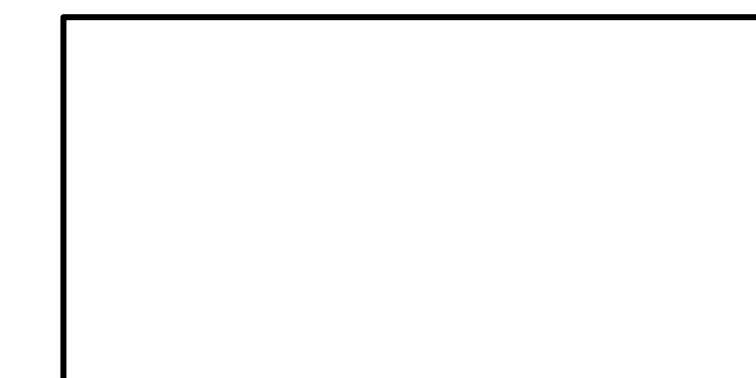
cut 2 of each:
3 1/2" square



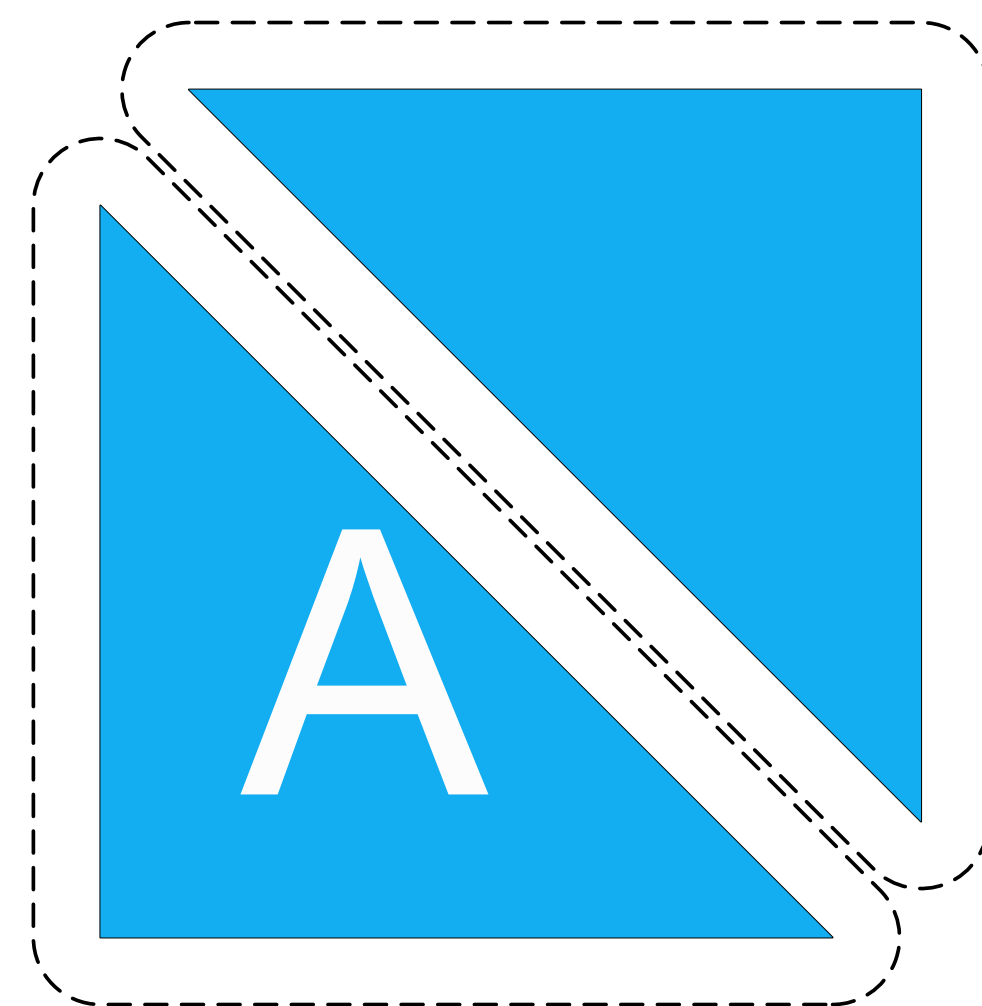
cut 2 of each:
3 1/2" x 6 1/2"



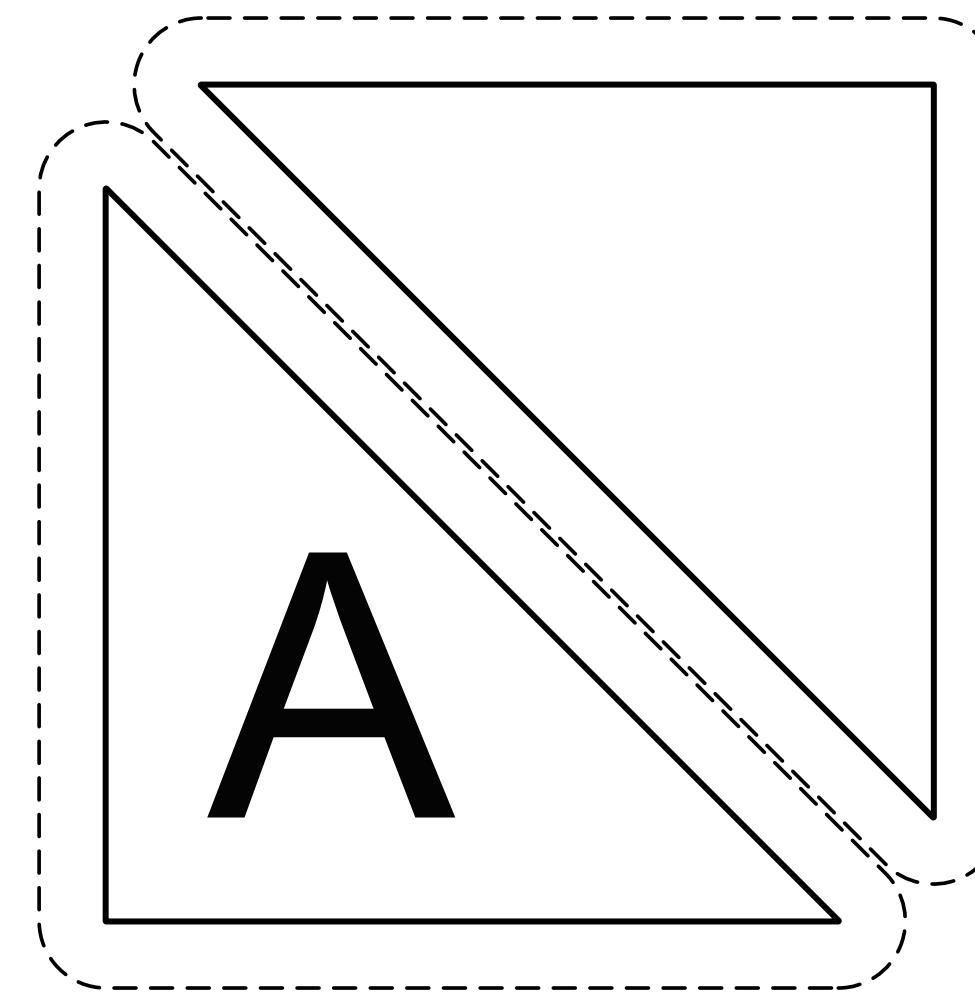
cut 4:
3 1/2" x 6 1/2"



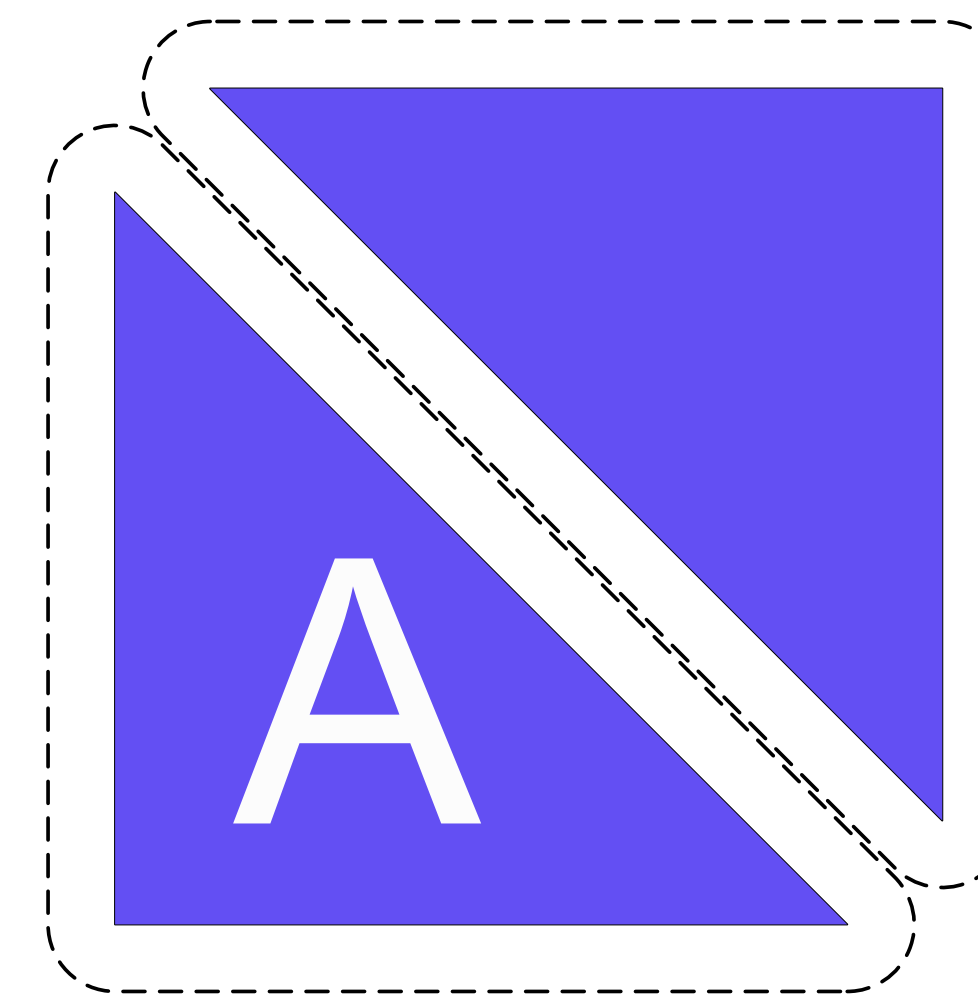
Cut two squares 6 1/2" then cut diagonally for outside corners.



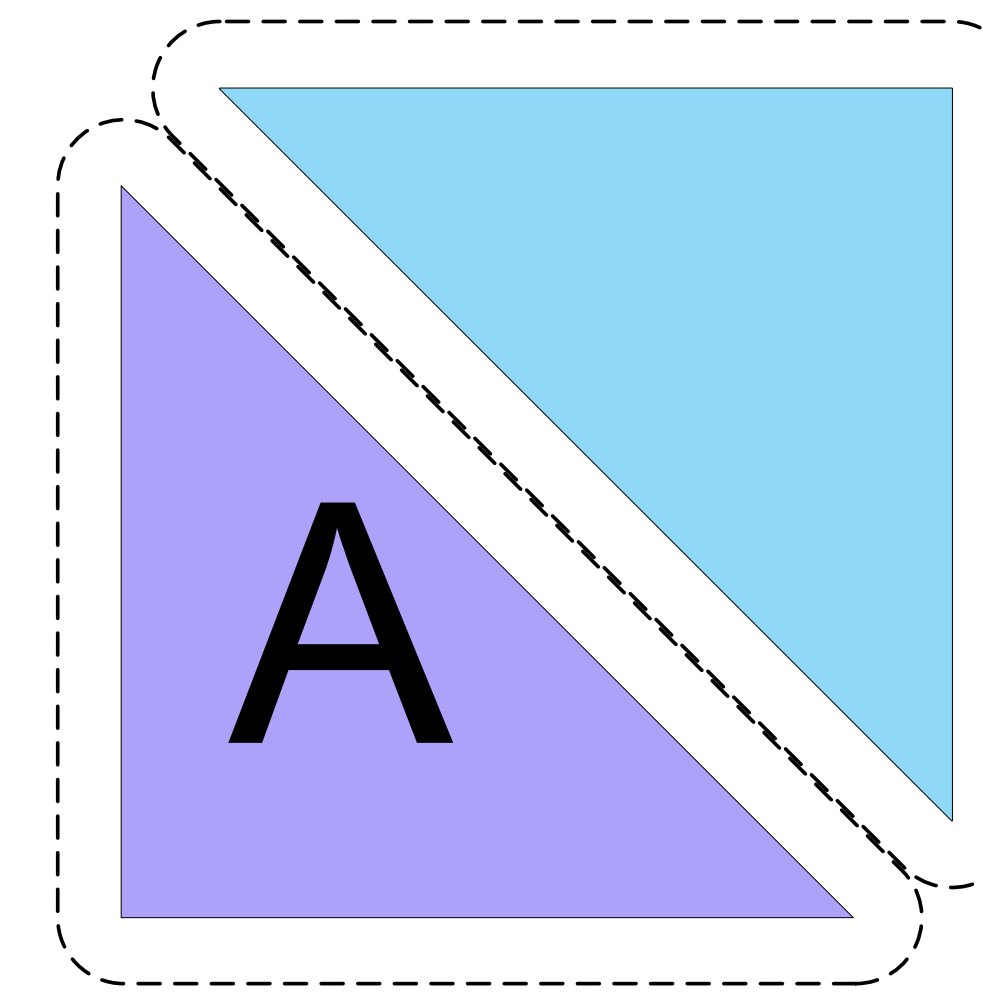
Cut two 7" squares for outside edges, then cut in half diagonally. After sewing, trim excess.



Cut one 7" square for HST. After sewing, trim to 6 1/2"



Cut two 7" squares for outside edges, then cut in half diagonally. After sewing, trim excess.



Cut one 7" square of *EACH COLOR* for HST. After sewing, trim to 6 1/2"
